Before You Board

Documentation: Ensure your passport or travel documents are valid for at least 6 months post-cruise.

App: Download the Carnival HUB app to manage your booking, dining, and daily activities.

Packing: Bring a carry-on with essentials like swimsuits and medications, as checked bags arrive later.

Reservations: Pre-book specialty dining, shore excursions, and spa treatments to secure your spot.

Embarkation Beverages

Soda / Non-Alcoholic Beverages: Guests may bring a small quantity of non-alcoholic beverages in their carry-on luggage. Limited to a maximum of **12 cans or cartons per person** of **12 oz. (354 ml) or less** (no heavy plastic bottles or hard-sided containers).

Wine & Champagne: Guests (21+ years old) may bring **1 bottle of wine or champagne (750 ml)** per person in their carry-on luggage. Additional bottles are prohibited.

Onboard Must-Dos

Dining: Explore the variety—from Guy's Burger Joint to elegant main dining room meals.

Entertainment: Catch a production show, live comedy, or the late-night deck parties.

Relaxation: Visit the Serenity Adult-Only Retreat for a quiet escape from the bustle.

Activities: Take advantage of onboard fun like waterslides, mini-golf, and trivia games.

Navigating the Ship

Deck Maps: Familiarize yourself with your ship's layout—decks, elevators, and stairs—on Day 1.

Sail & Sign: Use your Sail & Sign card for all onboard purchases; keep it handy at all times.

Safety: Attend the mandatory safety briefing as soon as you arrive.

Cruising Pro-Tips

Excursions: Book through Carnival to ensure you are back at the ship on time, even if delays occur.

Connectivity: Consider a Wi-Fi package if you need to stay in touch, but remember to embrace the unplugged life!

Gratuities: These are automatically applied to your account, but you can adjust them at Guest Services if you wish.

Practical note: Policies, excursion availability, and onboard rules can change—verify details before your sailing.
