Make Sure to Pack

Documents: Passport/ID, cruise boarding passes, luggage tags, and medical info.

Essentials: Comfortable walking shoes, swimwear, sunblock, and light layers for cooler AC inside.

Tech & Power: Phone charger, power bank, and a non-surge-protected power strip (required).

Toiletries: Personal medications, basic first-aid kit, and your favorite travel-sized toiletries.

Cruising Hacks

Book Early: Reserve dining and entertainment in the NCL app as soon as your window opens.

Use the App: Download the NCL app for daily planners, messaging other guests, and ship navigation.

Freestyle Dining: Enjoy the freedom of eating whenever and wherever you want—just make reservations for specialty spots!

Quiet Spots: Seek out the observation lounge or library for hidden, peaceful areas during the day.

Embarkation Beverages

Non-Alcoholic Drinks: NCL generally prohibits guests from bringing personal beverages on board.

Wine & Champagne: Guests may bring bottles of wine or champagne; however, they are subject to a corkage fee per bottle, regardless of where they are consumed.

What NOT To Do (Don'ts)

Don't bring prohibited items: Items such as irons, steamers, candles, or heating elements are strictly forbidden.

Don't arrive late: Ensure you are at the port in plenty of time for your boarding window.

Don't ignore the dress code: NCL's "Freestyle" is casual, but shirts and footwear are required in dining rooms.
