Before You Board

MedallionClass: Download the Princess MedallionClass app to manage check-in, dining, and your onboard experience.

Documentation: Have your passport or official travel documents ready for a smooth embarkation.

Packing: Bring a carry-on with your essentials, including medications and swimwear, for immediate access.

Reservations: Pre-book specialty dining and excursions via the Princess Cruise Personalizer online.

Embarkation Beverages

Non-Alcoholic Drinks: Guests may bring a small quantity of non-alcoholic beverages (sodas, juices) in their carry-on luggage. Limited to **12 sealed cans or cartons (12 oz. each) per person**.

Wine & Champagne: Guests (21+ years old) may bring **1 bottle (750 ml) of wine or champagne** per adult per voyage in their carry-on luggage. Additional bottles are subject to a corkage fee.

What NOT To Do (Don'ts)

Don't bring prohibited items: Items such as heating pads, candles, irons, or hard liquor/spirits are not permitted onboard.

Don't pack ID in checked bags: Always keep your passport, cruise documents, and medications in your carry-on luggage.

Don't skip the muster drill: Ensure you complete the mandatory safety briefing as soon as you arrive.

Don't bring your own liquor: Outside alcohol, other than the allowed wine/champagne, will be confiscated.

Onboard Must-Dos

Dining: Enjoy the varied options, from the inclusive Main Dining Room to specialty treats like the Crown Grill.

Entertainment: Experience Movies Under the Stars, production shows, and engaging enrichment programs.

Relaxation: Unwind at the Lotus Spa or the adults-only Sanctuary for ultimate peace and quiet.

Activities: Take part in trivia, wine tasting events, and the many daily activities listed in the Princess Patter.

Cruising Pro-Tips

Shore Excursions: Book through Princess to ensure your tour is protected if the ship schedule changes.

Connectivity: MedallionNet Wi-Fi is available; purchase in advance for the best savings.

Gratuities: These are automatically added to your stateroom account, but you can adjust them at Guest Services.
