



Royal Caribbean Cruise Guide

"From Bucket lists to boarding passes!"

Before You Board

App: Download the Royal Caribbean App before your cruise to check in, book dining, and view daily planners.

Documentation: Ensure your passport or required travel documents are readily available for embarkation.

Packing: Pack your essentials in a carry-on, including swimwear and documents, for immediate access.

Reservations: Book your specialty dining, shows, and shore excursions early via the Cruise Planner portal.

Embarkation Beverages

Non-Alcoholic Drinks: Guests may bring a small quantity of non-alcoholic beverages (sodas, juices) in their carry-on luggage. Limited to **12 standard cans, bottles, or cartons (17 oz. or less) per stateroom**.

Wine & Champagne: Guests (21+ years old) may bring up to **2 bottles (750 ml each) of wine or champagne per stateroom** in their carry-on luggage on embarkation day.

What NOT To Do (Don'ts)

Don't pack prohibited items: Leave irons, steamers, heating pads, candles, and liquor/hard spirits at home (they will be confiscated).

Don't put documents in checked bags: Never pack your passport, ID, boarding passes, or meds in checked luggage—keep them with you in your carry-on!

Don't skip the safety drill: Failing to complete the mandatory safety briefing can delay sailing or result in warnings.

Don't wear swimwear in main dining: Keep swimwear to the pool decks; follow the evening dress codes for the Main Dining Room.

Onboard Must-Dos

Dining: Experience everything from complimentary Main Dining to upscale specialty venues like Chops Grille.

Entertainment: Enjoy Broadway-style shows, ice skating performances, and live music throughout the ship.

Activities: Challenge yourself on the rock wall, FlowRider, or enjoy the waterslides and pools.

Relaxation: Spend time at the Vitality Spa or the adults-only Solarium for some quiet rejuvenation.

Navigating the Ship

Wayfinding: Use the digital touch-screen directories located throughout the ship to find your way.

SeaPass: Your SeaPass card is your stateroom key and your main method for all onboard purchases.

Safety: Participate in the required safety briefing—review the guide in your app as soon as you arrive.

Cruising Pro-Tips

Shore Excursions: Book directly through Royal Caribbean to guarantee that the ship waits if your tour is delayed.

Connectivity: VOOM internet packages are available; pre-purchase before your cruise for the best rates.

Gratuities: These are automatically added to your account daily, but can be adjusted at Guest Services if needed.

Practical note: Policies, excursion availability, and onboard rules can change—verify details before your sailing.
